



Eloisa Marie Aubert, born in Luxembourg in 2014 into a musical family, began studying the violin at the age of four. At just five years old, she was admitted to the Conservatoire de la Ville de Luxembourg in the class of Professor Vania Lecuit and currently continues her studies with Professor Zakhar Bron at the Zakhar Bron Academie in Switzerland.

Despite her young age, Eloisa has already achieved remarkable success in numerous prestigious international competitions. In 2025, she was awarded the Grand Prix and First Prize (Category A) at the International Violin Competition Andrea Postacchini, along with multiple First prizes, including at the Geneva Junior Music Competition, Austria's Goldene Note, International Competition for Young Musicians "Nutcracker.", and a Third Prize at the Anton Rubinstein International Competition – Violin Junior.

Among her other distinctions are First Prize and Absolute First Prize at the Barcelona International Young Artists Competition (2024), First Prize and Special Prize at the Hedwig International Competition for Young Violinists in Berlin (2024), and First Prize and Special Prize at the Saulius Sondeckis International Competition for Young Violinists (2024). She has also been awarded First Prize at the Stockholm International Music Competition (2023, 2024) and the "Nouvelles Étoiles" Competition, Second Prize at the Kocian International Violin Competition (2024). In her home country, she has repeatedly won First Prize and the Grand Prix at the Concours Jeunes Solistes in Luxembourg.

As a soloist, she has already performed with various orchestras, including the Zakhar Bron Festival Orchestra, the Luxembourg Philharmonic, the Orchestre de Chambre de Luxembourg, the Moscow Philharmonic Orchestra, the UniArt Orchestra Paris, and La Camerata IMEP, and has appeared in prestigious venues such as the Mozarteum, the Ehrbar Saal, the Luxembourg Philharmonie, the Tchaikovsky Concert Hall, and the Franz Liszt Academy of Music.

With her exceptional musical sensitivity, technical brilliance, and strong stage presence, Eloisa Marie Aubert is already attracting international attention as a rising young violinist.
